EXPECTATIONS

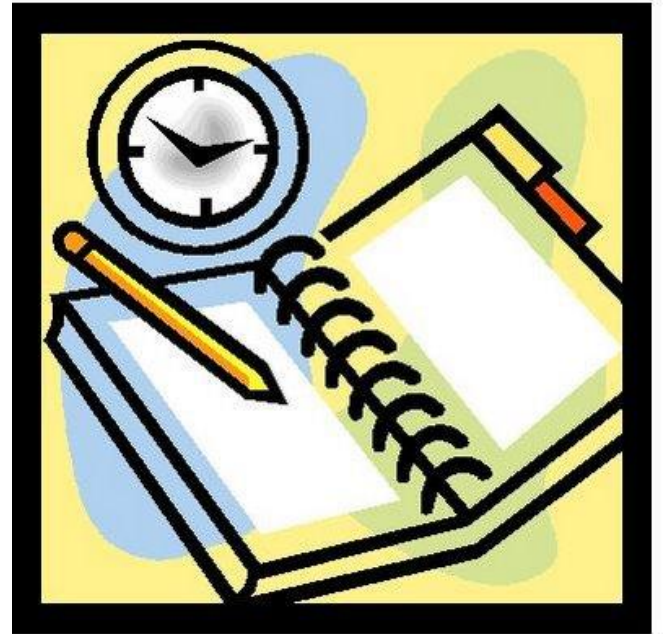
You should treat distance learning with the same mentality you treat in-person learning. This means:

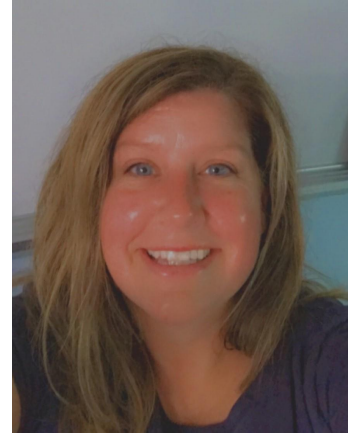

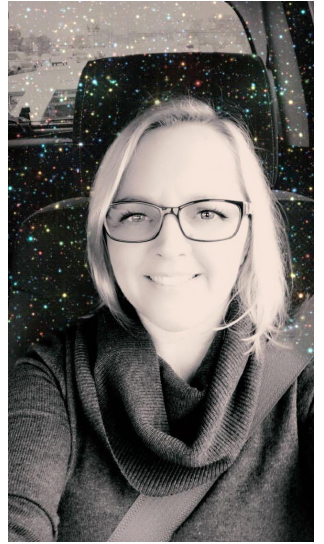
